
YEAR ONE <u>Neusletter</u>

Dear Parents and Carers,

<u>Maths</u>

This week we have been focusing on numbers to 50. We began by looking at 20, 30, 40 and 50, thinking about how many tens were in each number. The children have been practising counting up and back in tens to 100. Next, we looked at groups of tens and ones. The children used their knowledge of tens and ones to work out what the groups of tens and ones represented (two groups of ten + three ones = 23). Finally, the children partitioned numbers to 50 into tens and ones, using a part-whole model.





<u>English</u>

We have been learning facts about ladybirds this week from books and videos. The children then wrote down as many facts as they could remember and did a brilliant job! We were so impressed with how many facts they remembered.

<u>Science</u>

This week, we learnt about how to grow a plant. We discussed the different steps that need to happen in order to grow a healthy plant. The children then wrote up each step in clear instructions. After half term, the children will get a chance to grow their own plants in Year 1, so they will certainly be ready to grow and look after them!

Design Technology

We looked at different types of puppets this week in DT and the children enjoyed watching a few short videos of examples of puppets (one of their favourites being from the Sound of Music)! In the next few weeks, the children will be designing and making their own hand puppets.

Religious Education

We learnt about 'Good Friday' when Jesus was crucified. We discussed why it is called Good Friday and the children created some artwork to represent this day.

<u>History</u>

We went back in time 1000 years and learnt about William the Conqueror and the Battle of Hastings. We discussed how different life was 1000 years ago, compared to today and how they used tapestries to tell stories.

<u>PE</u>

We had Adrian, a specialist cricket coach, teach Year 1 PE this week where they learnt some bat and ball skills. The children did so well and we look forward to another cricket lesson from Adrian next Monday!
