Phonics

We have been recapping our new sounds this week, focusing on reading words containing these sounds:

Maths

In Maths this week, the children were very excited to start using rulers to measure length. They learnt to begin measuring at the 'zero' and practised using the rulers to measure straight lines to the nearest centimetre. We also continued subtracting numbers within ten and writing subtraction number sentences that represented word problems.

Woodland Learning

We had a lovely Woodland Learning session on Monday. We were very lucky with the weather and the children enjoyed making dens and bug hotels out of pipes, playing in the leaves, making musical instruments out of pots and pans and climbing trees!





English

In English, we made predictions about what we thought would happen next in our 'Pumpkin Soup' story. The children wrote their predictions in their own words, trying to add as much detail as possible.

In SPaG we have been consolidating all we have learnt about writing sentences this term, by writing sentences with clear finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. We have also been unscrambling and ordering words into a sentence to make sure the sentence makes sense.
