English

Phonics

Maths

In Maths this week, we made comparisons between containers and stated which held more/less/an equal amount of capacity. We also ordered pictures of cups showing an amount of liquid, from empty to full. We also used number lines, or the counting on technique to find number bonds to 20.

S<u>cience</u>

This week in science we sorted objects into groups using sorting hoops. The children worked in groups of three to decide how they would sort their objects (hard/soft, waterproof/not waterproof, translucent/opaque, etc) and worked together to sort the objects correctly.
