#### English


### <u>Maths</u>

In Maths this week, we have been finding parts and wholes of numbers. We began by using double sided counters. We sorted them into two groups based on their colours (the parts) and counted how many we had in total (the whole). Next, we used the part-whole model to help us write and solve addition number sentences.



# <u>Science</u>

We began our 'Seasons' science topic this week by introducing the four different seasons and going on an Autumn walk around the school grounds. We looked for signs of autumn by finding fallen leaves of different colours. The children then drew autumn pictures and wrote about the changes that happen this season.









#### PF

In PE, we have been learning dances that link to our 'Seaside' topic. This week, we focused on creatures that you find at the seaside or under the sea. We created movements for different animals and linked the movements into a sequence, which we then performed to the rest of the class.
