Maths

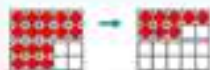
In mathematics, we have continued our learning from last term with a focus on multiplication and division, exploring it through the concepts of grouping and sharing. Following that, we progressed to the topics of doubling and halving, as well as identifying odd and even numbers.



$$4 \times 2 = 8$$

$$4 \times 2 = 8$$

$$\text{Double } 4 = 8$$



$$10 \div 2 = 5$$

$$\text{Half of } 10 = 5$$



Even numbers can be divided by 2 to give a whole number answer.
