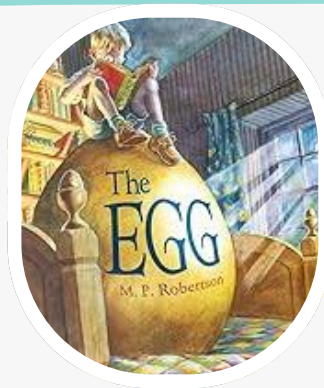

Term Five Week Three

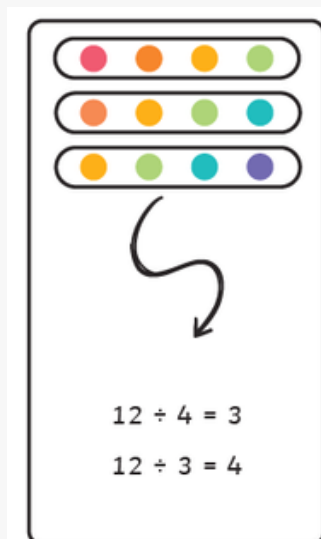
English
