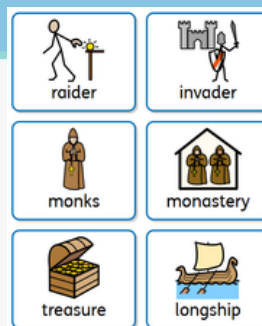
English
