English

In English this week we first looked at the different settings in our story the Robot and The Bluebird. We then labelled what we could see in the pictures. Then we came up with one or two adjectives to describe the nouns we labelled. After that we used our noun phrases and we wrote a descriptive piece of writing about our chosen settings.



Maths

This week we continued our shape learning, specifically, counting the vertices (corners) of a 2D shapes and finding lines of symmetry. We have also been practising how to draw these shapes, ensuring that we have the right amount of sides, vertices and making sure the sides were straight by using a ruler.

Computing

The children were learning about taking good photos. We looked at two photos of the same objects but they were slightly different. The children had to decide which photo was better and why. We then took photos of a classroom display, a view out of a classroom window and a pot of pencils. We then came back together and looked at each others. We discussed what things we could do to improve the photos. For example, zoom in or out, remove something from the background or make sure the object is in focus. After that, the children re-took their photos with their suggested improvements. It was a fantastic lesson!
