Times Tables tests will start up again on Monday.


English

We used the poem and our creations to predict what the book might be about.



For each pair of shapes, tick the shape with the greater area.




Maths


With Miss Courtney, the children will cover measurement for the next couple of weeks. On Tuesday, children learnt that area is the amount of space taken up by a two-dimensional shape or surface. They explored different ways of working out the area of a shape for example by using sticky tapes. On Wednesday, we drew shapes after being given the total area.


To the left are some examples of our learning.

Geography

In geography lessons, we have completed our topic of The Rhine and the Mediterranean. The children learnt the countries bordering the Mediterranean Sea and studied the importance of Suez Canal. We have started on the new topic of Population.

RE

The topic for RE this term is Incarnation. We studied the Big Frieze depicting the Bible timeline, created by the artist Emma Yarlett, and went on to locate the part of the frieze



representing Incarnation. Incarnation is in the New Testament and includes the Gospels.
