In English, the children planned and created adverts for a caravan based on the one in Danny and the Champion of the World. The children have created some amazing posters. Here are some of them.



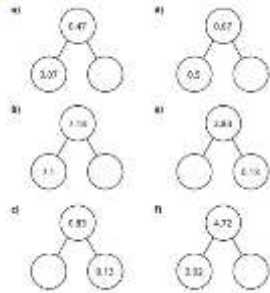
PE

We have continued practising cricket skills this week.

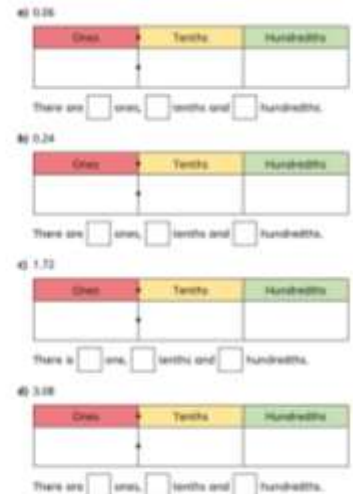
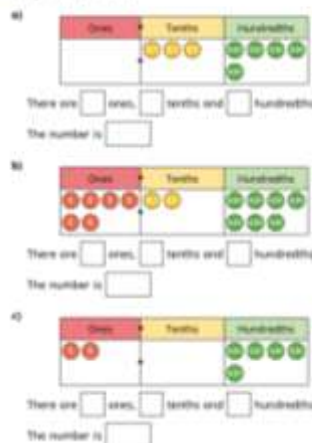


Maths

4. Complete the partition models.



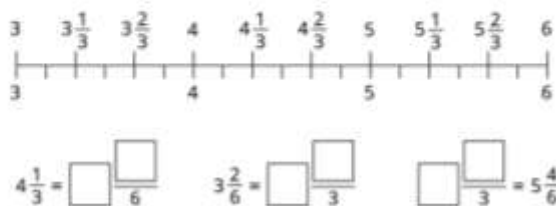
5. What number is represented in each place value chart? Complete the sentences.



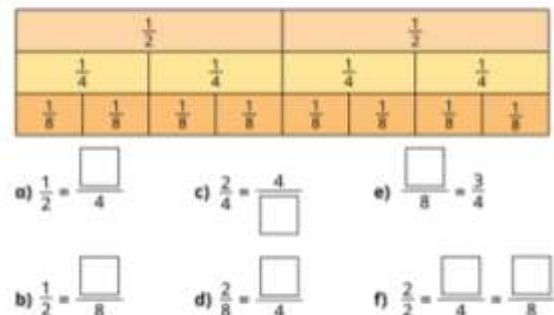
In maths, children have been learning the place values of decimal numbers and partitioning them in various ways.

3. Use the fraction wall to complete the equivalent fractions.

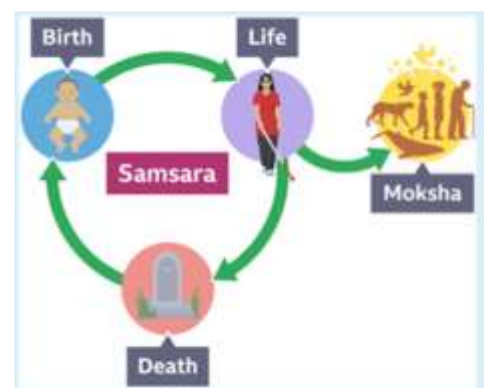


RE

This week in RE, we learnt two new terms: Karma and Moksha.

Karma is the force produced by a person's actions in one life that influences what happens to them in future lives.

Hindus believe in the concept of reincarnation. Moksha is the freedom from the eternal cycle of life, death and rebirth (Samsara). Attaining Moksha is the ultimate goal of a Hindu, as the Atma (soul/ spirit of God) becomes one with Brahman.



The children were fascinated by this concept of life and asked several interesting questions. They made comparisons and links to other religions and cultures that they have studied previously.
