This week in maths the children have begun to learn about angles, beginning with knowing that there are 90 degrees in a quarter turn, 180 degrees in a half turn, 270 degrees in a three-quarter turn and 360 degrees in a full turn. They then learnt to identify acute, obtuse, reflex and right angles, before learning how to use a protractor to measure angles.
