Maths:

This week, we have been learning about negative numbers. The children have solved fluency, problem-solving and reasoning questions. We have also been working on solving arithmetic questions. In addition, the children have continued to focus on having a quick recall of the times tables.

English:

We have continued reading our class book, Letters from the Lighthouse, by Emma Carroll. This week, the children wrote a descriptive piece about Budmouth Point – the village featured in the book. The children also wrote a piece describing emotions; for this piece they focussed on using abstract nouns. The children have also been practising their reading and comprehension skills.

Science:

In Science, the children learnt about reflection. They worked in small groups to make their own periscopes. After a bit of a rushed start, the children focussed well and read the instructions properly, which enabled them to successfully make a working periscope.

Latin:

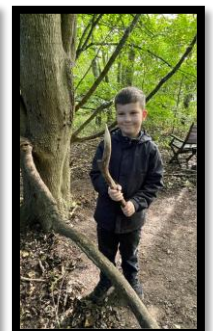
The children continued to build sentences using a variety of feminine and masculine words.
