Maths:

This week, we have continued to read and write numbers to 10 million. We have also been multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000, as well as comparing and ordering numbers. In addition, we have been solving arithmetic questions.

English:

We have continued reading our class book, Letters from the Lighthouse, by Emma Carroll. The children wrote a piece focussed on using speech punctuation -there are several rules to remember and the children did very well. In addition, the children wrote a playscript and an informal letter this week. The children also worked on their reading comprehension, answering questions about one of the chapters.

Science:

In Science, we started our topic, Light. First, we re-capped what the children remember from studying Light in year 4. We then learnt that light travels in straight lines. In addition, the children learnt how to explain how we can see things because light travels in straight lines from a light source to an object and then to our eyes. The children worked in groups to model this.


Next week in Science, we need cereal boxes – please could you send some in if you have any? Many thanks in advance.
