What a fantastic week! I am so proud of the children and their amazing performances on stage this week for our Nativity. I hope you enjoyed the performance, it was so lovely to welcome you all into school. Thank you all for coming.







In phonics this week the children have been reviewing all the Phase 2 phonemes we have learnt over the last two terms, the Tricky Words too! After Christmas we will move onto Phase 3. The children cannot wait for more new sounds!

The children have had fun making lots of Christmas things this week. They have been making Christmas cards and calendars and have been getting messy using the paint and glitter! They have also really impressed me with the fantastic writing they have all done on their Christmas card inserts!

Reception and KS1 have a Christmas letterbox in the corridor so if the children would like to write Christmas cards they can post them in the box and then our Year 6 children deliver them to the classroom. The children have been enjoying posting their cards!

Reception are having their Christmas Party (with KS1) on **Tuesday 17th December** in the afternoon.
