- It is bordered by Wales and Scotland.
- The official London home of the British Monarch (King or Queen) is Buckingham Palace.
- A white rose is the symbol of England.

#### Scotland:

- Scotland is at the northern end of Great Britain.
- The capital city is **Edinburgh**, but the largest city is **Glasgow**.
- The highest mountains in the UK are in Scotland.

### Wales:

- Wales is called Cymru in Welsh.
- English and Welsh are the two official languages of Wales.
- Cardiff is the largest city as well as the capital of Wales.
- The national emblems if Wales are the leek and the daffodil.

#### Northern Ireland:

- Northern Ireland is the smallest country in the United Kingdom. It makes up a part of the UK but is situated on an island in Western Europe called Ireland.
- Northern Ireland takes up a small part of the island of Ireland, while the rest of Ireland is an independent nation, the Republic of Ireland.
