Common materials and properties		
Brick	Rectangular blocks of baked clay used for building walls, which are usually red or brown.	
Fabrics	Cloth or other material produced by weaving together cotton, wool or other threads.	
Metal	A hard substance such as iron, steel, gold, or lead. Hard, strong, shiny.	
Plastic	A material which is light in weight and does not break easily. Strony, shiny, bendy.	
Rock	The hard substance which the Earth is made of rough uneven and not smooth shiny things are bright and reflect light smooth no roughness, lumps, or holes soft not rough or hard stiff firm or does not bend easily stretchy slightly elastic. Hard, strong.	
Wood	The material which forms the trunks and branches of trees. Hard, strong, stiff.	
Glass	Transparent, Smooth, Stiff.	
Water	Runny, wet, clear
