The most effective way to ensure a lasting and positive impact of the funding on PE provision throughout the school is to develop teachers' skill and confidence in the teaching of the subject.

## Summary of Sports Premium Grant spending 2020-2021

The Sports Premium Funding this year was used to specifically support the stated aim of "encouraging the development of healthy, active lifestyles". Much attention was paid to the promotion of active before school, break and lunch times, through the provision of enhanced physical resources, play spaces and positive role models. We developed the outdoor environment to provide an additional play surface for pupils to use during break and lunch times, and offered new play equipment to encourage pupils to be active during these periods. In addition, we continued to support the development of the Physical Education curriculum, primarily through the improved provision of opportunities for outdoor and adventurous activity challenges, both individually and within a team.
