
Reception Newsletter

In phonics this week the children have been continued to review different endings in words such as 'er' endings in brighter, sleeper and boaster. The children have learnt that if they hear an 'er' sound at the end of words it is usually 'er' as in 'a bigger digger.' The children have also focused on 'est' endings such as:



smartest, clearest and brownest. The children know the 'e' makes an 'i' sound in these words. We have also been working hard on reading and writing the following Tricky Words: the, go, I, no, you, said, have and like. Please continue to work on the Tricky Words you have at home, the children are doing really well and are becoming more fluent with these words.

The children had a great time digging holes, playing in the mud kitchen, swinging in the trees and playing in the stream during our Woodland Learning session this week.

Our school trip to Leybourne Lakes was brilliant! The children did really well as we did a lot of walking and it was so so hot! We found lots of great minibeasts during our pond dipping session; the children absolutely loved this activity with the rangers!
