


SCIENCE

In science this term, we will be learning about and exploring our five senses of sight, hearing, taste, touch and smell. We will also be identifying and naming the different parts of our bodies.



ENGLISH

We will be recapping how to use our phonics knowledge to segment words to spell and to form words into simple sentences. Our writing will draw inspiration from books we read in class this term such as 'The Night Pirates', 'Not Now, Bernard' and 'The Hairy Toe'.

We will also have a strong focus on letter formation and will have handwriting sessions so the children can practise forming their letters correctly.

PHONICS

We will begin by recapping the sounds that the children learnt in Reception. Then we will introduce new graphemes from phase 5: ay (play), ou (cloud), oy (toy), ea (each). We will practise reading and writing words with these new sounds in.

ITALIAN

The children will begin learning Italian with Mrs Ward. This term, they will learn to say colours, days of the week, animals and family members in Italian.




PE

In PE this term, we will be focusing on dance. We will learn sequences of movements linked to the themes of the seasons Autumn and Winter. We will also be working on our core strength, control and balance in yoga.

COMPUTING




We will explore how technology helps in daily life, identify computer parts, develop mouse and keyboard skills and learn to use technology safely and responsibly, including knowing who to ask for help with online content that feels uncomfortable.

MATHS

We will begin Year 1 by consolidating our understanding of numbers to 10. We will find one more and one less than a number, make comparisons by using language such as 'greater than, less than, equal to'. We order numbers to 10 on a number line and find missing numbers. We will also start to read and write numerals to ten as words.

Next, we will add and subtract numbers to ten, using pictorial representations, part-whole models, number lines and fact families.




RELIGIOUS EDUCATION



The children will learn to identify what a parable is. They will study the story of The Lost Son and begin to think about what the story means to Christians. They will also consider what it means to be forgiving and how we show forgiveness. The children will develop their understanding of how God is important to Christians and why they worship Him.

PSHE



In PSHE we will be learning about 'Being me in my world'. We will learn about what makes us feel safe and special, as well as looking at some of the rights and responsibilities that we have as a member of the class.
